National Education Union (NEU) Industrial Action

You are probably aware that the National Education Union (NEU) members across all schools in England are due to hold their second strike on Wednesday 1st March 2023. At this point, we believe that this will have **no impact** on classes at the Carlton Junior and Infant Academies.

This means that **all children must attend as normal** on the strike action day; we are able to keep both academies open as normal, as far as we know at this point.

However, we would like to point out that unions do not disclose which staff are in which unions, and the staff themselves do not have to tell us in advance if they are going to strike. They can also change their minds about taking strike action up to the day of the strike. If we are notified in advance of any further changes, we will endeavour to let you know at the earliest opportunity.

There are further strike action days on Wednesday 15th March and Thursday 16th March. We will let you know as soon as possible about the arrangements for these days.

We would like to thank you for your patience and understanding around the uncertainty these strike days cause.
