

These Co-curricular clubs will be on offer in the Autumn term:

Warhammer Club

A club where pupils can use their Design and Technology skills to paint Warhammer figures and share their knowledge and expertise.

This club will be run by Miss Hickling and will take place every Friday lunchtime.



Film Club

This will be a limited numbers event that runs monthly in the hall. The club is run by Miss Tolley and the PFA.

Handball Club
