I am delighted to be able to tell you that The Carlton Junior Academy has been chosen by Redhill Academy Trust to take part in a new project called, 'Greater Futures'. Therefore, today, <u>every child</u> in the academy has received their own brand new iPad and stylus which will be theirs to use in lesson time to support their learning, as the teacher directs.

The teachers and teaching assistants have been working extremely hard since the summer term, to train as Apple Teachers so that we can deliver the curriculum using Apple iPad technology to support teaching and learning.
